**Meeting of the 2010 SIS Strategic Plan Update “Breakout Group on Implementation Issues” to be Held**

Tallahassee, Fla. – Florida's Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) is a transportation system made up of statewide and regionally significant facilities and services. It contains all forms of transportation for moving both people and goods. The initial SIS Strategic Plan was adopted on January 20, 2005. The 2010 SIS Strategic Plan Update will consist of a comprehensive review of SIS goals, objectives and policies and will develop strategies to make SIS implementation more effective. It will also update and clarify the criteria and thresholds used to designate SIS facilities.

The Florida Department of Transportation has convened a Leadership Committee to provide overall guidance during the 2010 SIS Strategic Plan Update process and to make recommendations to the department on key policy issues. The Leadership Committee has formed five “Breakout Groups” to address the topics of Emerging SIS, Trade & Logistics, Urban Issues, Community & Environment, and Implementation Issues. The Breakout Group for Implementation Issues will meet on Friday, April 24, 2009 at the Florida Department of Transportation, 605 Suwannee St. Tallahassee in the Lafayette Conference Room. The meeting will begin at 1:00 p.m. and adjourn approximately 3:00 p.m.
