**DESCRIPTION GUIDELINES**

Descriptions for Roadway Projects: SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name FROM: SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name  
 TO: SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name

Descriptions for Bridge Projects: SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name Official Bridge Name Bridge  
 NOxxxxx

Descriptions for Intersection Projects: SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name @ SRxxx (USxxx) Local Name  
 Intersection

Descriptions for Interchange Projects: Use a “/” when identifying and interchange; e.g. I-xx/I-xx. If one  
 or both legs of the interchange are state or local roads, put the  
 local name in parentheses, SR 688 (Ulmerton Rd.)

Description of Interstate Projects: I-xx (SRxxx) Local Name

Descriptions should always be written in a format such that someone outside the Department would be  
 able to locate the project and determine the type of work to be accomplished.

Only those abbreviations on the standardized statewide list should be used – everything else should be  
 spelled out. Local names identifying an entity covered by a standard abbreviation should be spelled out;  
 e.g., for Bay County Transit System use Bay Co. TS not BCTS.

If a roadway has a US Highway number or a State Road Number in conjunction with a local road name,  
 use both only when space is available. If both will not fit, put the US Highway Number/State Highway  
 Number on the top line and put the local name in the additional description lines.
