PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This is one of five mainline widening projects in Broward County and includes an interchange/toll plaza replacement. This project begins at the Homestead Extension of Florida's Turnpike (HEFT) and ends just to the north of Johnson Street. The Hollywood Boulevard interchange and toll plaza will also be replaced as part of this project. The typical section consists of widening the mainline to eight lanes throughout the project limits. The Hollywood Boulevard interchange will be re-configured so that the toll plaza will be relocated to the south of its present location and the ramps will be reconstructed to conform to the new toll plaza site. In addition, a separate entrance ramp will be constructed to connect Hollywood Boulevard (just west of the Turnpike) to the southbound mainline.
