State Road 23 to Lane Avenue (State Road 103)

Duval County

Project Overview

NEEDS ASSESSMENT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is currently in the design phase of adding additional lanes to Interstate 10 from State Road 23 (Branan Field Chaffee interchange) to Lane Avenue (State Road 103). I-10 needs to be widened from four to six lanes to improve capacity and reduce congestion. The Chaffee Road Bridge (overpass) does not meet minimum clearance standards. I-10 is an emergency evacuation route. During evacuations, I-10 is extremely congested.

PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

Project Development study – Winter 2002 (Completed)

Design – Spring 2004 (Ongoing)

Right of Way acquisition – Winter 2005 (Ongoing)

Construction - Fall 2009

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The improvements consist of adding one additional lane in each direction in the median and replacing the Chaffee Road Bridge from Crystal Springs Road to General Avenue.
