



I-10 AT HAMMOND BOULEVARD NEW INTERCHANGE Duval County Project Overview

NEEDS ASSESSMENT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is currently in the design phase of a new interchange at Interstate 10 and Hammond Boulevard. The existing Marietta interchange will move to Hammond Boulevard.

PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

Project Development study – Summer 2001 (Completed)

Design – Fall 2006 (Ongoing)

Right of Way acquisition – Spring 2008

Construction - Winter 2010

PROJECT OVERVIEW

A new interchange will be constructed at Hammond Boulevard. A four-lane roadway on Hammond Boulevard will be built from Ramona Boulevard to US 90 (Beaver Street).

Design \$1.9 million (funded in 2006/2007 fiscal year)

Wetland Mitigation \$6 million (funded in 2008/2009 fiscal year)

Right of Way \$12 million (funded in 2007/2008 fiscal year)

Construction \$51 million (funded in 2010/2011 fiscal year)
